

# Daily Lectionary for the Season After the Epiphany, the Season of Lent and Holy Week

Christmas 2009 lasts twelve days up to the Epiphany, January 6, 2010.

Epiphany means “reveal.” Lakeland celebrates Epiphany for the first time this season. In the Eastern Church January 6th celebrates the Baptism of our Lord Jesus... “And a voice from heaven said, This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased.” (Matthew 3:17) On January 6th, the Western Church (Catholic) commemorates the coming of the wise men to the infant Jesus and the Baptism of Jesus on the following Sunday. Either way, a lot of Jesus’ life time is hurried along. The Jesus story gets told. The important point to make clear is Jesus revealed identity: He is the Son of God, the incarnate God, the King of the Universe (1 Corinthians. 8:6).

I can’t think of a better way to tell the story of Jesus than using the church’s calendar - Advent, Christmas, Epiphany, Lent, Holy Week, Easter, Pentecost, Ordinary Season after Pentecost. All of these Holy Days celebrate the life of Jesus - it tells the whole story in one year. Each year our children (and we are included) hear the good news. Lean into this calendar. Lakeland provides excellent resources to help you spiritual develop your family.

And remember, Morning Prayers/Lectio Divina is each Wednesday morning at 6:30 a.m. Bring your Bible, journal and pen.

How to find your day: Find the Sunday PRECEDING the week you are in. For instance, if today is Wednesday, the correct Wednesday is the Wednesday closest to the previous Sunday (last Sunday).
